

**PROCLAMATION.**

BY

**HIS EXCELLENCY THE HIGH COMMISSIONER.**

**No. 17 of 1926.—PROMULGATED 2nd JULY, 1926.**

**Entitled the Purchase of Stock (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Amendment Proclamation, 1926.**

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the Purchase of Stock (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation 1923 (herein after referred to as the principal law);

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

1. Nothing in the principal law contained shall be deemed to exempt a general dealer who acquires by barter or exchange any live stock elsewhere than at premises at which he is licensed as a general dealer or any person who by virtue of a licence issued under the principal law acquires live stock by barter or exchange, from liability to obtain a hawker's licence under the law relating to such licences in respect of the giving or disposing of any goods or articles in exchange for such live stock.

2. This Proclamation may be cited for all purposes as the Purchase of Stock (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Amendment Proclamation, 1926, and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
