

## PROCLAMATION.

### Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Fugitive Criminals Surrender Proclamation, 1908 (No. 14 of 1908), (hereinafter referred to as "the said Proclamation") whereby provision is made for the surrender of fugitive criminal in the Bechuanaland Protectorate;

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the powers in me vested, I do hereby declare, proclaim and make known as follows:—

### Amending Sub-Section 1, Section 3, of Proclamation No. 14 of 1908.

1. Sub-section (1) of section *three* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "before whom he is brought on *habeas corpus* or any similar writ of proceeding" and the substitution therefor of the words "or of the Court of the Resident Commissioner before which he is brought upon an application for release."

### Amending Section 17.

2. Section *seventeen* of the said Proclamation shall be and is hereby amended by the deletion from the penultimate paragraph thereof of the words "a magistrate" and the substitution therefor of the words "the Court."

### Commencement of Proclamation.

3. This Proclamation shall be read as one with the said Proclamation and shall have force and take effect from the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
