BECHUANALAND PROTECTORATE DEFENCE
(FINANCE) REGULATIONS, 1939.

RESTRICTION ON RECEIVING OF PAYMENTS IN
UNION CURRENCY FOR EXPORTS.

In terms of the powers vested in the Resident Commissioner by Regulation 4 A of the Bechuanaland Protectorate Defence (Finance) Regulations, published under High Commissioner's Notice No. 227 of 1940, it is hereby notified for general information that no person may, except with the permission of a bank authorised under the said Regulations to deal in foreign exchange, receive payment in Union currency in respect of goods or other property exported by him from the Bechuanaland Protectorate to any country other than the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the Union of South Africa, Southern Rhodesia, Northern Rhodesia, Basutoland and Swaziland.
