**HIGH COMMISSIONER'S NOTICE**

**No. 158 of 1941.**

It is hereby notified for general information that, under and by virtue of the powers vested in him by section *two* of the Regulation of Works and Machinery (Bechuanaland Protectorate) Proclamation, 1934 (No. 40 of 1934), His Excellency the High Commissioner has been pleased to make the following amendment to the Regulations published in the Schedule to the said Proclamation:—

Regulation 19 (6) is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following words:—

“ and in all cases where cages are used for lowering or raising persons, gates at least four feet in height from the floor of the cage shall be provided for use when persons are travelling, to prevent them from inadvertently falling out of the cage. Only when work in the shaft is being carried out may the gates be dispensed with.”
