(1) No person shall export or cause to be exported any dry fish produced from fish originating from Botswana.</p> <p>(2) The prohibition referred to under subregulation (1) shall be for a period of 12 months from the date of publication of these Regulations.</p> <p>(3) The prohibition referred to in regulation (1) shall not apply to licensed fish farms.</p> | Prohibition of export of dry fish |
| <p>3. A person who contravenes any provision of these Regulations commits an offence and shall be liable to a fine of P200 and imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months.</p>  | Offences and penalties            |
