THE BOTSWANA HONOURS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1968

(Published on the 13th December, 1968)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Botswana Honours Act, 1967 (No. 21 of 1967), His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Regulations —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Botswana Honours (Amendment) Regulations, 1968.

Amendment of Regulation 9 in Statutory Instrument No. 52 of 1967

2. Regulation 9 of the Botswana Honours Regulations, 1967, is amended by the addition of the following subregulation —

“ (3) A clasp to the medal shall be attached to the ribbon when the medal itself is worn. A small star emblem denoting the award of each clasp shall be worn on the ribbon when the ribbon only is worn.”
