THE SUBORDINATE COURTS (DISTRICTS) (AMENDMENT) NOTICE, 1969

(Published on 5th June, 1969)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Subordinate Courts Proclamation (Chapter 5), the Minister of State prescribes the area described in the Schedule hereto as a district for the purposes of the said Proclamation, and revokes that part of the Schedule to the Subordinate Courts (Districts) Notice, 1969 (Statutory Instrument No. 35 of 1969) which relates to the Northern Magisterial District.

SCHEDULE

Northern Magisterial District

The area which comprises the Ngamiland Administrative District, the Chobe Administrative District, the Northeast Administrative District, the Francistown Administrative District, that part of the Central District north of Latitude 21° South together with a strip of land the boundaries of which are defined as commencing at the intersection of Latitude 21° South with the middle of the Shashi River thence generally southwards and eastwards along the middle of the Shashi River to its confluence with the middle of the Ramaquabane River; thence due south for a distance of 10 miles; thence generally westwards and northwards following a line parallel to and 10 miles distant from the middle of the Shashi River to the intersection of this line with Latitude 21° South; thence eastwards along Latitude 21° South to the point of commencement.
