SCHEDULE

NXAI PAN NATIONAL PARK

Commencing at a point in the middle of the road running beside the old Bushman Pits to Pandamatenga Stock Route due west of borehole BH.249 (Geological Survey Map – BATAWANA AND STATE LANDS WATER DEVELOPMENT – drawn by C. Matshaba, 1966 and filed at the office of the Director of Geological Survey, Lobatse), the boundary runs north-eastwards following the middle of the said Bushman Pits to Pandamatenga road to a point where it is intersected by the southern boundary of the Tamafupa Controlled Hunting Area (No. 4) as described in Statutory Instrument No. 15 of 1968; thence eastwards on the said boundary to a point where it is intersected by Longitude 25 degrees east, thence due south following the said line of Longitude to the point where it is intersected by Latitude 20 degrees south, thence westwards following the said line of Latitude to a point due south of the point of commencement; thence due north to the point of commencement.
