## ECTION

In Act to authorize the raising of a loan from the Kreditanstalt Fur Wiederaufbau to finance the construction of a new pitumen road between Francistown and Serule.

Date of Assent: 18.12.75

Date of Commencement: 31.12.75

NACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Francistown/Serule Road Loan Short title Authorization) Act, 1975.
- 2. The Minister may raise by loan from the Kreditanstalt fur Authorization Viederaufbau (hereinafter referred to as "KFW"), subject to such to raise loan erms and conditions as may be agreed between the Minister and CFW, sums not exceeding in the aggregate the equivalent of 18 000 000 (Eight million rand) for the purpose of the construction f a new bitumen road between Francistown and Serule.
- 3. All sums required to repay the loan authorized to be raised by Loan charged his Act and to pay the interest and other charges thereon are charged upon Consolidated pon and shall be repaid out of the Consolidated Fund.

- 4. The proceeds of the loan authorized to be raised by this Act shall be paid into the Development Fund.
- 5. The Minister is hereby empowered to sign on behalf of the Government of Botswana any agreements embodying the terms and conditions of the loan as agreed in accordance with section 2, and to authorize any public officer to sign such agreements, and to do all such things as may be necessary to effect or facilitate such loan or such agreements.

Terms and conditions to be laid before Parliament 6. As soon as practicable after the raising of the loan the Minister shall present a paper to Parliament containing a report on the loan and setting out the terms and conditions of the loan and any further information relating thereto as he may consider it appropriate to include.
