SCHEDULE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Works and Communications by section 2 of the Public Roads Act, the following Notice is hereby given —

Citation	1. This Notice may be cited as the Establishment and Proclamation of the Francistown—Ramokgwebana Road Notice, 1982.
Establishment and proclamation of Francistown-Ramokgwebana road	2. The Francistown-Ramokgwebana road, the general course and situation of which are more fully described in the Schedule is hereby established and proclaimed to be a public road.
Width of road	3. The width of the road referred to in paragraph 2 shall be 30,5 metres from either side of the centre line of the made surface, except that where the road is in such proximity to the railway reserve that the half width of 30,5 metres is not feasible, the boundary of the road shall be taken as being coincident with the boundary of the railway reserve.
