### ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

#### BYE-LAW

- 1. Citation
- 2. Amendment of bye-law 3 of Cap. 40:02 (Sub. Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Francistown Town Council by regulation 30 of the Township Regulations and with the approval of the Minister of Local Government and Lands, the following Bye-Laws are hereby made: —

- 1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Francistown (Abattoir) Citation (Amendment) Bye-Laws, 1986.
- 2. Bye-Law 3 of the Francistown (Abattoir) Bye-Laws is amended by substituting for paragrah (1) thereof, the following new paragraph of bye-law 3 of Cap. 42:02 (Sub. Leg.)
  - (a) use of abattoir for slaughtering, lairage water, inspection and stamping of meat shall be as follows —

Bull, ox, cow, heifer, steer or calf	12,00
Sheep, lamb, goat or kid	3,00
Pig	6,00
(b) charges for use of the freezer —	
Bull, ox, cow, heifer, steer or calf	2,50
Sheep, lamb, goat or kid	0,50
Pig	1,00''
