## TRADE DISPUTES ACT (No. 19 of 1982)

## TRADE DISPUTES (UNLAWFUL INDUSTRIAL ACTION) (BARCLAYS BANK OF BOTSWANA LIMITED EMPLOYEES) ORDER, 1989

(Published on 12th April, 1989)

WHEREAS it appears to the Minister that there is actual or declared Industrial Action by the employees of the Barclays Bank of Botswana Limited;

AND WHEREAS I am satisfied that the Industrial Action is either wholly or inpart in furtherance of a Trade Dispute whether existing or apprehended and I am satisfied that all practicable means for reaching a settlement of the Trade Dispute by way of procedures prescribed by the Trade Disputes Act have not been exhausted;

NOW THEREFORE IN EXERCISE of powers conferred on me, as Minister of Labour and Home Affairs by section 34 of the Trade Disputes Act, I hereby declare the said Industrial Action to be unlawful.
