APPRENTICESHIP WAGES ORDER, 1990
(Published on 1st June, 1990)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 57 of the Apprenticeship and Industrial Training Act, the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs, acting on the recommendations of the National Advisory Board for Apprenticeship and Industrial Training, hereby makes the following Order —

Citation and commencement 1. This Order may be cited as the Apprenticeship Wages Order, 1990, and shall come into operation on the 1st July, 1990.

Minimum wages 2. The following scale of wages shall constitute the minimum wages payable to persons entering into apprenticeships in any of the designated and apprenticeable trades listed in the First Schedule of the Apprenticeship and Industrial Training Act —

(a) 1st year of apprenticeship..... P153 per month

(b) 2nd year of apprenticeship.... P178 per month

(c) 3rd year of apprenticeship..... P263 per month

(d) 4th year of apprenticeship..... P397 per month

Revocation 3. The Apprenticeship Wages Order, 1988 is hereby revoked.
