IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs by section 34 of the Immigration Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Regulations, 1992.

Amendment of Regulation 16

- 2. Regulation 16 of the Immigration Regulations is hereby amended
 - (a) in subregulation (1) by substituting for the figure "P50" the figure "P80"; and
 - (b) in subregulation (2) by substituting for the figure "P25", the figure "P50".

Substitution of Regulation 17

3. The Immigration Regulations are amended by substituting for regulation 17 thereof the following new regulation —

"Appeal on refusal to issue residence permit

- 17 (1) An Appeal to the National Immigrants Selection Board by a person aggrieved by a decision of a Regional Immigrants Selection Board —
- (a) rejecting his application for a residence permit;
- (b) as to any condition attached to his residence permit; or
- (c) to vary or refuse to vary a condition attached to his residence permit,

may be made on payment of a fee of P30".

(2) An appeal to the Minister by a person aggrieved by a decision of the National Immigrants Selection Board on any matters in subregulation (1) may be made on payment of a fee of P60."
