AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE RIGHT OF APPEAL FROM THE COURTS OF BOTSWANA TO THE JUDICIAL COMMITTEE

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Judicial Committee (Abolition Short title of Appeals) Act, 1973.
- 2. From the date of commencement of this Act, no appeal shall No right of lie to the Judicial Committee from the courts of Botswana in respect appeal to of any case or any class of cases.

3. All written laws or applied laws relating to appeals to the Repeal Judicial Committee shall cease to have force and effect in Botswana.
