**AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE RIGHT OF APPEAL FROM THE
COURTS OF BOTSWANA TO THE JUDICIAL COMMITTEE**

Date of Assent: 25.9.73

Date of Commencement: 5.10.73

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Judicial Committee (Abolition of Appeals) Act, 1973. Short title

2. From the date of commencement of this Act, no appeal shall lie to the Judicial Committee from the courts of Botswana in respect of any case or any class of cases. No right of appeal to Judicial Committee

3. All written laws or applied laws relating to appeals to the Judicial Committee shall cease to have force and effect in Botswana. Repeal
